

<u>Business Spotlight</u>: Here Today Adopted Tomorrow/Rachael Max

I am the executive director and board president of Here Today Adopted Tomorrow Animal Sanctuary, Inc. (HTAT), a registered 501(c)(3) nonprofit in Brimfield. We help cats and the people who love them in the community, and we operate a cat shelter and offer many complimentary programs to support this mission.



With more than 40 years of collective experience in animal welfare, my mother, Barbara Horn, and I saw a critical need to help community cats through shelter and adoption services in and around southwestern Worcester and eastern Hampden and Hampshire counties.

We bought close to 30 acres of land along Route 20 in Brimfield, and in 2012, we co-founded HTAT. Our vision was to provide a cage-free cat shelter to serve the needs of homeless cats to provide a comfortable, low stress setting where they could live until they were ready to go to their new homes.

Today our shelter and adoption services remain an integral component of our mission, and we have expanded to meet community needs. For instance, we have a low-cost spay/neuter program to help area residents who couldn't otherwise afford to get their cat(s) spayed or neutered-we are also committed to spaying and neutering stray and feral cats, too.

We also run a Pet Food Pantry supporting people in the communities we serve, with pick-up locations in Brimfield, Southbridge, and Ware. We also provide pet food to food pantries in other towns. In addition, we provide free cat behavior counseling to people who otherwise may think they have no choice but to surrender their cat due to biting, scratching, inappropriate elimination, or other issues. And we have a Care for Life program, which is designed to cover medical costs of special needs cats who without this support might not get adopted.

In today's economy, many people are struggling to pay for food. Local food pantries can be a godsend to people-and pet food pantries provide ancillary relief to offset costs so they can better afford household necessities. HTAT's Pet Food Pantry is designed to provide such relief and we are inviting area businesses to join us as community partners on this front.

The cats and the kittens we have supported provide unconditional love, friendship, and companionship to their people, so it's a win-win for everyone involved. Our hope is to continue matching cats with loving people who will, in turn, reap the rewards of building an immeasurable bond with their new pet, and to continue serving the community through a wide range of community-focused programs to support cats and people.


